## How do I cite a work with two authors?

Citation within the text, separate the authors using "and". Example:
Ward and Taylor (2019)
According to Ward and Taylor (2019)
Citation in parentheses, separate the authors using ";". In this case, don't forget to write in uppercase. Example:
(WARD; TAYLOR, 2019).

## How do I cite a work with three authors?

Citation within the text, separate the authors using "," and "and". Example:
Lee, Abbott, and Smith (2019)
According to Lee, Abbott and Smith (2019)
Citation between parentheses, separate the authors using ";". In this case, don't forget to write in uppercase. Example:
(LEE, ABBOTT; SMITH, 2019).

## How do I cite a work with more than four authors?

For citations with more than four authors, use the expression "et al.".
See the examples:
Citation within the text:
Recently Gloor et al. (2003) published a study on the stability and acoustic characteristics of compressible viscous coaxial jets.

Citation between parentheses:

The Amazon basin plays an essential role in the climate regulation services storing large amounts of carbon as biomass (PHILLIPS et al., 1998).

## How do I cite two or more works of the same authors published in the same year?

In cases where the author(s) and year(s) are the same, use a letter after the year to differentiate them.

Citation within the text:
Takahashi (2002a, 2002b)
Camara et al. (2021a, 2021b)
Citation between parentheses:
(TAKAHASHI, 2002a; 2002b)
(CAMARA et al., 2002a; 2002b)

## What commands do I use in Latex for citations?

Citation within the text, use: \citeonline
Citation between parentheses, use: \cite

## Can I use numerical citation in my thesis?

> Yes, you can.

## If I don't cite the author, am I plagiarizing?

Yes. If you include a text of another author without citing and referencing it, it is considered plagiarism.
