INTERPLANETARY MAGNETIC PHENOMENA AND PROCESSES AND THE RESULTANT CONTROL OF GEOMAGNETIC ACTIVITY AT EARTH

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ABSTRACT

We present a summary of recent work and work-in-progress by the authors, to give an overview of the interplanetary features which cause various forms of geomagnetic activity: the very largest magnetic storms, major (Dst≤-100nT) magnetic storms, substorms, geomagnetic quiet and the quiet dayside aurora. The causes of solar cycle and seasonal variations in geomagnetic activity will also be discussed.

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
